Every youth is born for a reason. You are not an accident. You are not a mistake. You are a ‘divine idea’ wrapped in human form. God looked at the problems of this world, and instead of sending an angel, He sent ‘**you**’, because there is something in you that this generation needs.

Whether you were born in a palace or a poor neighborhood, greatness does not depend on where you start, it depends on what you carry inside and how you respond to it.

The Seed of Greatness in You

Every youth has a seed of greatness within. Just like every seed has the potential to become a mighty tree, so also every young person carries potential that can shake the nations. The tragedy is not in being small, it is in remaining small because you never discovered what was planted in you.

A small seed of mango may look ordinary, but inside it lies a forest of fruits. You may look ordinary now, but inside you are dreams, books, songs, inventions, and ideas that the world has never seen.

Your background does not determine your future; it only explains your starting point. What you make of your life depends on your response to God's purpose for your life.

You Are More Than Your Circumstances

Let's face it, not every youth has a fair beginning. Some were born into wealth, others into poverty. Some have supportive parents, others are orphans. Some enjoy quality education, while others struggle for survival.

But hear this truth and note it down: **Your circumstances may describe you, but they don't define you.** God has used people from all kinds of backgrounds to do great things.

I have special counsel for the following categories of people.

The Street Hustler: Are you hustling around the street to make ends meet. Maybe you are a young man/lady selling pure water or bread just to survive. Many will see you as poor, but God sees you as a potential entrepreneur, a leader, or a philanthropist. Greatness begins when you decide that this hustle is not your destiny. I want to inform you that that is your divine training ground. Don't miss the purpose.

The School Dropout: Maybe you dropped out of school because of finances or failure. That does not mean your life is finished. Some of the world's greatest minds inventors, writers, and business owners started from failure. If you keep learning, thinking, and improving, your story can still inspire millions.

The Quiet Student: Are you a youth who has a very low self-esteem, so you are quiet, shy, indifferent and often ignored. But hidden in that quietness may be deep wisdom, creativity, and spiritual strength. Don't envy loud people. Know that even diamonds are silent stones until they shine. So, breakthrough out of your situation and discover the God-given purpose for your life.

The Struggling Christian Youth: Are you there? Maybe you love God but keep falling into sin or discouragement. Don't give up! Though Peter denied Jesus, yet he still became a great apostle after repentance. God uses broken people to make beautiful testimonies. Gather up yourself, you are very valuable in the hand of God.

The Overconfident Youth: There are these categories of youths who think they already "know it all." They boast about their gifts and looks. I have this counsel for you; Without humility, talent becomes a trap. Remember, character sustains what talent attracts. The humble always rise higher in the long run. Be humble under the hand of God, and let him bring you into the full understanding of your life and purpose.

Greatness Requires Process

A lot of young people want to manifest greatness immediately; they want the glory without the story. I want to inform you that **true greatness takes time and training.**

A seed does not become a tree overnight. It must go through dark soil, heat, and rain. The process of growth may not be comfortable, but it is necessary. A seed that decides to rebel the process will never grow out of the ground; it would eventually be buried with all its potentials.

When a caterpillar transforms into a butterfly, it struggles in the cocoon. If someone helps it out too early, its wings will never be strong enough to fly. Likewise, your challenges are part of your strengthening process. God is using every test to prepare your wings for flight.

So, don't despise your small beginnings. The place where you are now, that small class, that small room, that humble start, is your training ground for greatness.

My question to you today is what will you do with the opportunity available for you now that you are young? What will your life be in the next five to ten years? The Choice you make today will determine the future you will have.

Discovering Your Purpose

Greatness begins when you discover why you were born. Ask yourself the following questions:

What am I passionate about? What problems do I feel called to solve? What gifts or talents come naturally to me? How can I use them to honor God and help others?

It is purpose that gives direction. Without it, even the most talented youth can waste energy chasing everything and achieving nothing. Don't join the cat and rat race.

A quote by Myles Munroe says **“When purpose is not known, abuse is inevitable.”** Don’t just chase money or fame; chase meaning. When you walk in purpose, success follows naturally.

Greatness is not for lazy people. It belongs to those who wake up early, study, plan, pray, and act. Every time you say “No” to wrong things and “Yes” to growth, you are moving closer to your greatness.

I use this opportunity to Challenge to every Youth:

THE PATH OF TRANSFORMATION

“...Be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind.” – Romans 12:2

Transformation is not just about becoming different; it is about becoming better. It is the bridge between in-born potential and manifestation. It is the road between where you are and who you were meant to be.

Defining Transformation

Your body is the temple of God, don't trade your destiny for a few minutes of pleasure. There is a saying that "Purity preserves power", therefore keep yourself pure from this dangerous cankerworm. Break away from any wrong relationship, it is capable of destroying your bright future.

Laziness and Procrastination

Laziness is the thief of destiny. Many youths keep saying, "I'll do it later," until "later" becomes never. Every day wasted in idleness is a day stolen from your greatness. No one ever became exceptional by sleeping too much or waiting for things to "just happen." Greatness requires effort, diligence, and consistency.

Addiction to Social Media and Distraction

A true sense of belonging comes from purpose and positive relationships, not from violence and bloodshed.

Examination Malpractice and Deception

Cheating may give temporary success, but it builds a false foundation. **You may pass the exam, but you fail the lesson of life.**

Integrity matters. The strength of your character determines how long your success will last. A quote says: “A lie may travel fast, but truth travels farther.” One day, your failure will be made known to the world.

Greed and the “Get-Rich-Quick” Syndrome

Many young people today want money without process; they want luxury without labour. This is why internet fraud (“Yahoo Yahoo”), ritual killings, and scams have become widespread.

But the truth remains that ill-gotten wealth carries hidden sorrow. You cannot build a lasting future on fraud. Every stolen coin buys temporary pleasure but eternal regret. The Book of wisdom says; “Wealth gotten by vanity shall be diminished.” – Proverbs 13:11

Pride and Rebellion

Some youths believe they know everything. They mock authority, reject correction, and despise elders. But pride always leads to downfall. When you refuse to be corrected, you close the door to wisdom. When you rebel against guidance, you derail your destiny. Note that Humility is not weakness; it is strength under control.

Peer Pressure and Wrong Associations

“He that walks with the wise shall be wise, but a companion of fools shall be destroyed.” – Proverbs 13:20. You cannot soar like an eagle if you walk with chickens. Many destinies are lost because of the wrong company. Your friends influence your choices, your language, and your habits. If your closest friends are unserious, immoral, or negative, you will soon become like them. Choose friends who push you upward, not those who drag you down.

Ungratefulness and Entitlement Mentality

A lot of youths today feel entitled, they want rewards without responsibility, and help without humility. Gratitude is a mark of maturity. Entitlement, on the other hand, blocks blessings.

When you are thankful, you attract favor. But when you complain, you repel opportunity. Learn this lesson: “Be grateful for little; it will open doors for much.”

Gossip and Careless Speech

Words are powerful. Some young people destroy friendships, reputations, and opportunities with careless talk. Avoid gossip, slander, and negative speech. Speak words that build, not words that break. Don’t forget that “Life and death are in the power of the tongue.” So be watchful about what you say or do.

Neglecting Spiritual Encounter and Growth

Today’s youths are often too busy for God, too busy to pray, too distracted to read the Bible, and too tired to attend fellowship.

Dear youth, neglecting your spiritual life is like unplugging your phone from its power source. You may still work for a while, but soon your strength will fade. Develop a solid personal relationship with God your maker, and seek His face for virile spiritual life. Transformation begins when you stay connected to your source, God.

Five Steps to Genuine Transformation

1. Decide to Change

3. Submit to Mentorship

You can never outgrow guidance. Everyone who succeeds in life has someone they listen to. Find teachers, mentors, or spiritual leaders who model integrity and excellence. They will correct you in love and guide you with wisdom.

“The eyes that refuse instruction will soon cry over destruction.”

4. Return to your Maker (GOD)

Transformation begins in your heart. Ask God to change your desires and renew your mind. When you draw close to Him, He replaces confusion with clarity, guilt with grace, and fear with faith. He also empowers the decision you have taken for total transformation. Except God changes you, you cannot be changed. Let your prayer be: “Lord, change me from within.
